I am a Consultant Gynaecologist, Reproductive Medicine (IVF) and Surgery Specialist, and was appointed Consultant Obstetrician, Gynaecologist and Reproductive Medicine Specialist to Gateshead Health NHS Foundation Trust in January 2006.

I studied at University of Lagos, Nigeria, qualifying with MBBS and trained in Obstetrics & Gynaecology (MRCOG 1995, FRCOG 2011) in the UK.

I also completed training in Reproductive Medicine and undertook clinical and scientific research (MD 2002) looking into the cause(s) and treatment of Ovarian Hyperstimulation Syndrome (OHSS) under the supervision of Professor Alison Murdoch and Professor John Davison at International Centre for Life and University of Newcastle from 1996 – 1999.

I am currently one of three Consultants who run the Gateshead Fertility unit (GFU), which is the most successful IVF unit in the North East. The GFU is also part of the Obstetrics & Gynaecology department and are both research active.

I am currently a Peer reviewer for the British Journal of O & G (BJOG), Obstetrician & Gynaecologist, Human Reproduction, Fertility & Sterility and Human Fertility journals. I am a co-Director of Northern Fertility and Gynaecologist Services Ltd.

I have been an RGS co-opted Governor since 2009.
